Cookies

What are cookies?

Cookies are small text files that are placed on your computer or device when you visit a website. Cookies set by ADInstruments are called first party cookies and cookies set by other organisations are called third party cookies. Third party cookies used on our website are mainly for understanding how the website performs, your interactions with our website, keeping our services secure and providing advertisements that are relevant to you.

The types of cookies we use

Strictly Necessary Cookies

These cookies are necessary for the website to function and cannot be switched off in our systems. They are usually only set in response to actions made by you which amount to a request for services, such as setting your privacy preferences, logging in or filling in forms. You can set your browser to block or alert you about these cookies, but some parts of the site will not then work. These cookies do not store any personally identifiable information.
